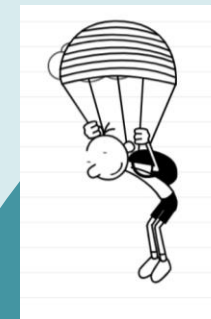
# Jeff Kinney

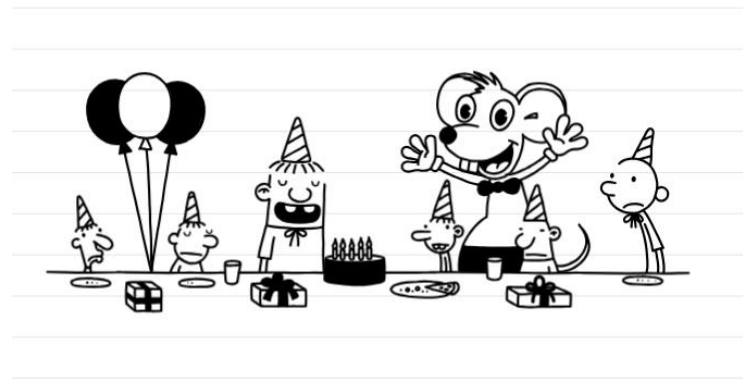



1. Two dots for eyes.
