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## Handwriting knowledge and Skills Progression Grid

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The ability for children to write legibly is essential in order for them to demonstrate their true potential throughout their school careers (and their lives beyond school) as well as ensuring that they have the ability to communicate effectively using writing.

Nelson handwriting encourages development of an individual style in each child through carefully structured stages, and fully covers the technical aspects of writing: letter formation, basic joins, printing, speed writing and slant.

Nelson handwriting progresses from pre-writing patterns through to the development of an individual style.
